

CITY OF TORONTO FLAG DESIGN COMPETITION

CONTEST RULES

- 1. All entrants must be resident in Metropolitan Toronto.
- 2. The submitted design must be on material no larger than $24\text{''} \times 18\text{''}$.
- 3. The material used must be suitable for easy display.
- 4. The submitted design must be accompanied by a completed entry form.
- 5. No more than one design may be submitted by any individual entrant.
- 6. An explanation of the design, including any colours and symbols, wherever possible, should be appended to the submission.
- 7. Competition entrants must sign the release on the entry form, forfeiting all title to the design amd relinquishing that title to the Corporation of the City of Toronto. Failure to do so may invalidate the entry.
- 8. Completed entry forms and designs must be received in the office of The City Clerk, 2nd Floor Podium, City Hall, Toronto M5H 2N2, not later than 4.30 p.m. (Eastern Daylight Saving Time), Friday, October 18th, 1974. Entries received after that date and time will not be entered in the competition.
- 9. All entries submitted by persons attending school as students should indicate age, grade and school of the entrant.
